FADING TROPES

- Possession (unless reinvented)
- Found Footage (oversaturated)
- Home invasion (too familiar)

New twists are required to stand out in this genre.

WHAT PRODUCERS WANT

- Contained, low-budget horror with high concepts.
- Unique subgenres and fresh spins.
- Scripts that hint at sequel/franchise potential.

MARKET ADVICE FOR WRITERS

- Don't follow the trend "understand" it.
- Choose subgenres that reflect your voice.
- Aim for originality and emotional clarity.
- Include a logline that hooks in under 30 words.
